COMPLIANCE WITH POPIA

The Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (**POPIA**) aims to give effect to the constitutional right to privacy, whilst balancing this against competing rights and interests, particularly the right to access information.

To achieve this, the POPIA sets out conditions for the lawful processing of personal information. POPIA seeks to regulate every step of the processing of personal information, from how personal information must be handled when it is collected until the time it is destroyed.

Huge Group Limited (**Huge Group**) continuously reviews its security controls and processes to ensure the personal information of our data subjects (stakeholders) are secure.

What is considered personal information?

Personal information is any information that can be used to reveal a person's identity. Personal information relates to an identifiable, living, natural person, and where applicable, an identifiable, existing juristic person (such as a company), including, but not limited to information concerning:

- race, gender, sex, pregnancy, marital status, national or ethnic origin, colour, sexual orientation, age, physical or mental health, disability, religion, conscience, belief, culture, language and birth of a person;
- information relating to the education or the medical, financial, criminal or employment history of the person;
- any identifying number, symbol, email address, physical address, telephone number, location information, online identifier or other particular assignment to the person;
- the biometric information of the person;
- the personal opinions, views or preferences of the person;
- correspondence sent by the person that is implicitly or explicitly of a private or confidential nature or further correspondence that would reveal the contents of the original correspondence;
- the views or opinions of another individual about the person; or
- name of the person if it appears with other personal information relating to the person or if the disclosure of the name itself would reveal information about the person.
